

#### RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

CMC-Ontario has a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with CMC-Canada effective December 1, 2017 with the financial provisions of the MOU that took effect on July 1, 2018. The MOU was for 5 years and 1 month with an option to extend for a further term of one year, up to a maximum of five renewal terms. In 2024, the MOU was further extended by 1 year until December 31, 2025

Under the MOU, CMC-Ontario appointed CMC-Canada as its agent to bill and collect all membership dues on its behalf and remit collections to CMC-Ontario. In addition, CMC-Canada provides national core services, collaborative growth and vitality projects, and Institute services. In exchange for acting as CMC-Ontario's agent and these additional services, CMC-Canada charges CMC-Ontario for services fees based on a percentage of membership fees collected.

# ICMCO BY-LAW CHANGES

### **ONCA & By-Laws Background**

- The Government of Ontario updated its legislation called the Not-For-Profit Corporations Act (ONCA) in 2010.
- The legislation allowed a transition period to implement the by-laws up to October 18, 2024
- This is our first AGM after the transition period, and we are presenting updated bylaws, that comply with the requirements set out in the ONCA legislation.
- Prior to this, our by-laws had been tweaked, issue by issue, on a base document that dates back to the 1990s or earlier.
- We used the opportunity to do a "complete review" of the document to make sure it was solid.



### **Key Changes**

- Key Findings: Our By-laws weren't too bad.
  - Careful observers will note that the new document is quite similar to the old one.
  - Substantively, Membership, Affiliated Persons, and Discipline Sections have minimal changes.
  - Many outdated ideas (from the 1990s) were embedded this was part of the clean up.

#### The Changes:

- We removed "detailed procedures" from the by-laws and moved them to policies
  - Fellows Committee
  - Firm Memberships
- Meetings Special Meetings required if demanded by either 35 Members or 10% of Members
- Remove references to third parties from our by-laws, replaced with "Agents"
- A lot of tidying up of details, organization references, corporation types, legal updates, etc..
  - Language on incapacity, bankruptcy, etc.
  - Not require a physical head office
  - Improved and updated the audit language



#### **BY-LAW 5.1:**

### **Nominations By-Law**

#### **BY-LAW 5.5b:**

### **CMC-Ontario Council Composition**

If at the close of the nomination period the total number of nominated candidates is equal to or less than the total number of available positions on Council, the nominated candidates will be acclaimed and no vote shall be required. In such a situation, the Secretary of the Institute will advise the Members accordingly.


