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

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RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

CMC-Ontario has a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with CMC-Canada effective December 1, 2017 with the financial provisions of the MOU that took effect on July 1, 2018.

Under the MOU, CMC-Ontario appointed CMC-Canada as its agent to bill and collect all membership dues on its behalf and remit collections to CMC-Ontario. In addition, CMC-Canada provides national core services, collaborative growth and vitality projects, and Institute services. In exchange for acting as CMC-Ontario's agent and these additional services, CMC-Canada charges CMC-Ontario for services fees based on a percentage of membership fees collected. The term of the MOU ends on December 31, 2022 with the option to extend for up to five renewal terms of one year.

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From "Sponsors" to "Coaches"



Current Sponsor Requirement

Remove Sentence

• Every applicant for Member or Associate shall be sponsored by two CMCs who are members in good standing of the institute or of an institute in Canada that is a signatory to the agreement of Affiliation." Remove Sponsor Requirement, Create New Coaching Program

- Part of a "by-law cleanup and modernization."
- Sponsors were relevant in the 8o's and 9o's when "big firms" were our primary recruitment method.
- Sponsors today, when recruited, don't typically know the candidate.
- Today's new members, associates and candidates, may need help "navigating the process" but not being "escorted in the front door."
 - Highly problematic language
 - Removes an impediment to our growth
 - Encourages a more open Profession
 - Recognizes the reality of our newer members. Applicants and Associates
- Significant process work on "coaching" program.
- Strong, Cross-Institute Support.

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Ontario Council Composition



The Council of the Institute is composed of eleven (11) Councillors, comprising:

- a) Seven (7) Councillors to be elected by the Members:
- b) The Past President, who is a member of Council, but is not elected; and
- c) The Chair or a designate from each of the three (3) Chapters of the Institute.

The Officers: President, Vice-President and Treasurer/Secretary must be found within the director numbers/positions listed.





Nominations By-Law

By-Law 5.5 b:

If at the close of the nomination period the total number of nominated candidates is equal to or less than the total number of available positions on Council, the nominated candidates will be acclaimed and no vote shall be required. In such a situation, the Secretary of the Institute will advise the Members accordingly.

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
