ONCA & By-Laws Background

- Ontario updated its legislation called the Not-For-Profit Corporations Act (ONCA) in 2010.
- The legislation allowed a transition period to implement the by-laws up to October 18, 2024
- This is our first AGM after the transition period, and we are presenting updated bylaws, that comply with the requirements set out in the ONCA legislation.
- Prior to this, our by-laws had been tweaked many times, issue by issue, on a base document that dates back to the 1990s or earlier.
- We used the opportunity to do a "complete review" of the document to make sure it was solid.

The Key Changes

- Key Finding Our By-laws weren't too bad.
 - Careful observers will note that the new document is quite similar to the old one.
 - Substantively, Membership, Affiliated Persons, and Discipline Sections have minimal changes.
 - Many outdated ideas (from the 1990s) were embedded this was part of the clean up.
- The Changes:
 - We removed "detailed procedures" from the bylaws and moved them to policies
 - Fellows Committee
 - Firm Memberships
 - Meetings Special Meetings required if demanded by either 35 Members or 10% of Members
 - Remove references to third parties from our bylaws, replaced with "Agents"
 - A lot of tidying up of details, organization references, corporation types, legal updates, etc..
 - Language on incapacity, bankruptcy, etc
 - Not require a physical head office
 - Improved and updated the audit language
